Conception, Design & Architectural rendering of 44,000sq. ft. new sanctuary completed

### 2018 - 2019

Re-Evaluation of Church's needs, and more cost-effective options explored

### 2019

Approved design and build of 24,000 sq. ft. two story multipurpose building to provide administrative offices, youth ministries activity space, classrooms & flex space for events

Renovation of current sanctuary & repurpose of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> floors

Improvement of parking lots

### **April 2019**

Engaged T-Knowles & Assc. for Design/Build and Contractor of project with estimated cost of \$10.5 million

### 2021

Phase 1 – East Parking Lot permitted & construction of fenced paved 90 parking spaces completed

### 2022

Phase II – Final design and construction of multipurpose building and renovation of current sanctuary



### April 30, 2022

Final Designs & Building permits for Multi-Purpose Building

### June 1, 2022

Groundbreaking for new construction-20 months

### March 1, 2024

Renovation of existing sanctuary & completion of parking lot improvements-8 months




