1,243,794

That is the number of registered voters in Broward County. Can you imagine that only 21% of the entire 1,243,794 voted in August? That means that only 261,196 persons exercised their **RIGHT TO VOTE** in the August elections...a mere 1 out of every 5 people.

Of those 261,196 people:

52% voted by mail

17% voted early

31% voted on election day

Now, you tell me. Is that how we want to honor the struggle made by our parents, grand parents, great grands and ancestor for our **RIGHT TO VOTE?** I implore you Brothers and Sisters, let's turn this around. We get "a do over" in November, and we cannot afford to get another failing score for voter turnout.
