Men's Health Awareness

WHY MEN'S HEALTH AWARENESS MATTERS

Shorter Lifespan: On average, men live 5–7 years less than women

Higher Risk for Certain Diseases: Men are more likely to suffer from heart disease, certain cancers, and liver disease

Mental Health: Men are less likely to seek help for depression, anxiety, and suicidal thoughts



COMMON HEALTH ISSUES

- Heart Disease: Leading cause of death among men
- Prostate Cancer: Most common cancer in men after skin cancer
- Testicular Cancer: Most common in young men aged 15–35
- Depression & Suicide: Suicide rates are 3–4 times higher in men than women
- Diabetes and Obesity
- High Blood Pressure

KEY PREVENTATIVE ACTIONS

- Regular Check-Ups: Annual physicals, prostate exams (age 50+, earlier if genetic risk)
- Screenings: Cholesterol, blood pressure, colonoscopy
- Healthy Lifestyle: Balanced diet, exercise, avoid tobacco, limit alcohol
- Mental Health Check-Ins: Open up to a professional or trusted person



Focuses on educating men and boys about preventable health problems and encouraging early detection and treatment of disease. It encompasses physical, mental, and emotional well-being.

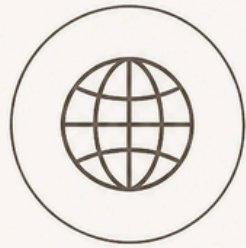

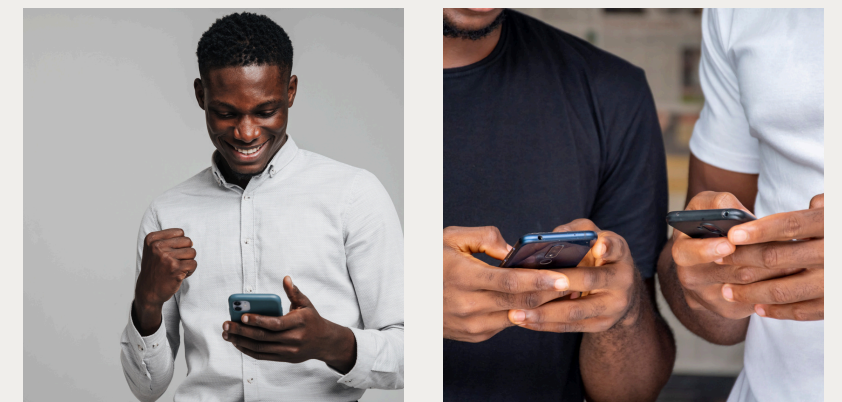
